

MASCO CLASSIC XV

TOURNAMENT RULES

All USA Hockey rules and regulations will be observed with the following exceptions.

1. A single timeout of one minute will be permitted in the Championship Game only.
2. Minor penalties will be one minute. Major penalties will be three minutes. Misconducts will be half the period.
3. Any player or coach receiving four penalties in one game will be out of that game and the following game also.
4. Any player or coach removed from a game for a game misconduct will not be permitted in the following tournament game.
5. Tie determination*:
 - A. Most points
 - B. Most victories
 - C. Face to face outcome
 - D. Goals against
 - E. Fewest penalties(tie breakers will not be revisited in the event of a tie between three of more teams)
6. The Championship Game, if ending in a tie, will be followed by one five-minute overtime, followed then by a shoot-out, as needed.
7. As long as time permits, all games will be stop time, even when the USA goal differential has been reached. If the game, however, is behind schedule and the USA goal differential exists, then the clock will be run.
8. Teams are required to exchange handshakes at the conclusion of each game.

Skills Competition- Shoot-Out and Team Relay

The Masco Classic Tournament holds two competitions in addition to the games. The Relay is a four-lap race with players passing a stick as a baton. Teams need to select six players (each to skate one lap) to enter the Team Relay. If your team can get past the qualifying heat, they can earn a shot at being number one! Next comes the Shoot-Out: the tension, the excitement of one-on-one breakaway hockey. In this Classic event each team will select shooters and one goalie to compete. In each round, shooters will have two minutes to get as many goals as possible with no rebounds (players will not shoot on their own goaltenders). Scores and saves are tallied, and the best goal scoring team and the stingiest goaltender are the winners! Awards will be given to the first place finishers in each competition.

Pin Exchange

Teams are encouraged to participate in a pin exchange prior to each game. The exchanges

will take place in the locker room.
